Learners with Learning Difficulties and/or Disabilities

If you are a learner with learning difficulties and/or disabilities leaving school you should have seen your Personal Adviser from Connexions. They can provide advice and practical help on several matters, including further education, training, voluntary work and employment. Young people with learning difficulties and/or disabilities can continue to receive support from Connexions up to their 25th birthday.

Special schools in Bromley offer 16-19 courses for their students and these are Marjorie McClure, Riverside and Glebe Schools. Students follow courses provided by the schools which most suit their needs and interests.

Colleges also have a range of courses and can provide additional support on mainstream courses. Most colleges also provide special courses which have smaller class sizes. Other choices include E2E (Entry to Employment) and Apprenticeships.

It may also be possible to attend a specialist college if local colleges are unable to meet the young person's needs.

Students at Burwood and Glebe Schools may wish to use this brochure to explore a range of course options in other 16-19 schools and colleges and should discuss their plans with their Connexions Personal Adviser in the first instance.

Learning Providers have to make reasonable adjustments for disabled people in line with the Disability Discrimination Act 1995. Examples of reasonable adjustments include alternative exam arrangements, extra support with planning during exam and assessment periods and access to a quiet room.

Financial Help

Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA for short) is a weekly payment and bonus scheme for eligible students. EMA can help pay for the travel costs, books and equipment you need to follow your course. It is paid in addition to any other benefits or support that the Government provide so, for example, being eligible for EMA will not affect your parents' or carers' Child Benefit. EMA was made available from September 2004, and already many young people in your area have benefited from the weekly and bonus payments.

Who is entitled to EMA?

To be eligible, you'll need to:

- Be 16-years-old on the 31st August 2008 and staying on at a school or college in England after GCSEs or,
- Be 17-years-old on the 31st August 2008 and continuing your studies at a school or college in England, and
- Have your own bank or building society account and,
- Live in a household with annual income up to £30,000 and,
- Meet the residency requirements of the scheme. (Please call the helpline or see the website for more information)

You must also be doing at least 12 hours per week of guided learning on a further education course in a School Sixth Form, Sixth Form college, Further Education College, Special School or Independent School. Any NVQ, GCSE or A- level course is acceptable – and in any academic and vocational subject.

Where can I study?

Most of the Bromley schools offer mixed Sixth Forms. You can choose to study in any College of Further Education, School Sixth Form or Work Based Training Provider. Work Based Training Providers combine day-release training and work experience or employment with on-site training and courses of study.

What are the different courses offered?

Qualifications – a quick guide

A2 (A Levels) In the second year students usually continue with some of the courses they started at AS and achieve A2 level qualifications. AS and A2 = a full A Level.

Advanced Extension Awards are designed to challenge the most able advanced level students, ensuring that they are tested against standards comparable with the most demanding found in other countries. The AEA is being withdrawn after the June 2009 examination series, except in Mathematics where the qualification will continue until at least June 2013.

Applied A Levels are A Levels which cover broad career-related areas such as Engineering, Performing Arts, Information Technology or Art and Design. They can be taken in various 'sizes' or numbers of units and can be studied alongside other Advanced Level Courses.

Apprenticeships not only train you in the skills employers want, they also open up further career and learning options. You can carry on working, do more advanced training or even go on to higher education.

As employees, apprentices earn a wage and work alongside experienced staff to gain job-specific skills. Off the job, usually on a day-release basis, apprentices receive training to work towards nationally recognised qualifications. Anyone living in England, over 16 and not in full time education can apply. Apprenticeships can take between one and four years to complete depending on the level of Apprenticeship, the apprentices' ability and the industry sector.

You can now apply for Apprenticeship vacancies online using a new system that lets you search for, view and then apply for Apprenticeships.

The National Apprenticeship Service (NAS) was officially launched in April 2009. The NAS will assume total responsibility for the delivery of Apprenticeships that includes: Employer Services; Learner Services; and a web-based vacancy matching system. This online system enables individuals to search and apply for live vacancies and allows employers, and their training providers to advertise their vacancies to a wide range of interested applicants.

AQA Baccalaureate (or AQA Bacc) comprises of four elements which together demonstrate that students have achieved success in terms of A-levels and wider learning and enrichment activities. Depth of study represented by GCE A-Levels. Breadth of study is achieved through AS General Studies, Critical Thinking or Citizenship. Independent Learning is demonstrated through the completion of an Extended Project. Students achieve personal development through enrichment activities.

AS Levels are the first half of a full A Level but are also a stand-alone qualification. In some schools and colleges certain subjects may only be available as an AS Level. Students can study up to five subjects over one year and gain an AS level in each subject.

BTEC First and Entry Level Certificates BTEC First Certificates and Diplomas are Level 2 vocational qualifications and provide the initial knowledge and understanding for students wishing to work or to take further study at Level 3.

BTEC National Certificates and Diplomas like Applied A Levels, cover broad career-based related areas such as Business Studies and Health and Social Care. Assessment is a mixture of coursework and exams. BTECs are available as 6 units (Award) 12 units (Certificate) and 18 units (Diploma).

CACHE Awards (the Council of Awards in Children's Care and Education) are a range of qualifications at Levels 2 and 3 aimed at preparation for working in Child Care and Education and may lead on to careers in child care, nursing or teaching.

Qualifications – a quick guide (cont)

CISCO Career Certification is recognised as the industry standard for computer network design and support.

Diplomas The Diplomas are an exciting range of new courses being offered in Bromley. They have been designed in partnership with employers and uniquely combine essential skills and knowledge with hands-on experience and employer-based learning to prepare a young person for work or further study. Diplomas will offer a mix of theoretical and practical learning and will be available at Levels 1, 2 and 3 (Foundation, Higher & Advanced Levels).

Entry to Employment (E2E) is a learning programme available for young people aged 16+. The programme is a good idea if you are not ready to go straight on to an apprenticeship programme, further education or work. Whilst on E2E you will get a training allowance plus travel expenses. The programme will be adapted to your needs and may include such things as confidence building, motivation, literacy and numeracy, IT and work tasters. You may also be able to gain qualifications whilst on the programme. For more information on E2E contact Connexions.

International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme is a challenging two-year curriculum, leading to a qualification that is widely recognized by the world's leading universities. Students study six subjects (three at higher level and three at standard level) together with a core made up of three separate parts - extended essay, theory of knowledge and creativity, action, service. The IB Diploma Programme prepares students for university and encourages them to ask challenging questions, learn how to learn, develop a strong sense of their own identity and culture, and develop the ability to communicate with and understand people from other countries and cultures.

NVQs (National Vocational Qualifications) are work-related, competence-based qualifications. They are available at Level 3 (Advanced Level), Level 2 (Intermediate Level) and Level 1 (Introductory Level) in a wide range of occupational areas such as Business Administration, Hairdressing, Catering, Motor Vehicle Repair and Construction. They reflect the skills and knowledge needed to do a job effectively, and show that a candidate is competent in the area of work. NVQs are achieved through assessment and training. Assessment is often through on-the-job observation and questioning. Candidates produce evidence to prove they have the competence to meet the NVQ standards. NVQs can be achieved as part of an Apprenticeship Scheme.
